I. General Information

Post doctoral fellowships are available through the SCRMC Fellowship program (all nationalities). The SCRMC postdoctoral fellowships are open to trainees who will work with members of the SCRMC listed on our website (<http://stemcells.wisc.edu/faculty>). Prospective postdoctoral applicants must first contact a potential mentor from this list of participating faculty. Only after discussion of potential research projects and mutual agreement may the application be submitted. The mentor must provide a letter of recommendation as part of the application process (may be submitted directly by the mentor to Sue Gilbert – see below).

The postdoctoral traineeships will be initially awarded for a one-year period, renewable for a second year upon demonstration of satisfactory progress. The current salary levels are available at <http://grants.nih.gov/training/nrsa.htm>
