I. General Information

The SCRMC Graduate Training Award Program is an interdisciplinary pre-doctoral program which aims to support the training of UW graduate students in interdisciplinary stem cell and regenerative medicine research. The program is funded by the UW SCRMC and is open to all nationalities.

II. Application Checklist

Complete the application form (following pages).

- A statement of training, prepared by the mentor, commenting on the promise of the applicant, describing the interdisciplinary nature of the student's thesis research, and detailing a plan for achieving interdisciplinary training. Examples of interdisciplinary training mechanisms include, but are not limited to: i) co-mentorship by investigators in distinct scientific disciplines; ii) enrollment in courses in multiple disciplines; iii) planned "student sabbaticals" that allow for dedicated training time in a discipline outside of the applicant's area of expertise. (1 page)

A brief research description, prepared by the student (2 page max), which includes:
 - 1) Title
 - 2) Specific aims as done in NIH grant but for 1 year project including hypothesis and brief experimental plan
 - 3) Significance section including impact on stem cell and regenerative medicine field
 - 4) Innovation section covering any interdisciplinary studies
- An updated version of the student's curriculum vitae, including a list of publications and presentations.
- Copies of the applicant's graduate school application materials, including undergraduate transcripts, graduate record examination (GRE) scores, and letters of recommendation.
