

The Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine Center Postdoctoral Training Award

I. General Information

Post doctoral training awards are available through the Stem Cell and Regenerative Center and are open to all nationalities. The SCRMC Graduate and Postdoctoral Training Award is open to trainees who will work with faculty members of the SCRMC listed on our website (<http://stemcells.wisc.edu/people>). Prospective postdoctoral applicants must first contact a potential mentor from this faculty list and, only after discussion of potential research projects and mutual agreement may the application be submitted. The mentor must provide a letter of recommendation as part of the application process (may be submitted directly by the mentor to Hollie Thompson -- see below).

A **letter of recommendation** is required from your doctoral (Ph.D., M.D., V.M.D.) advisor or from one other appropriate source. Please have these sent directly to Hollie Thompson at the above address.

Complete **Curriculum Vitae**.

Summary of the proposed research (2 page maximum) that includes the following:

- 1) Title
- 2) Specific aims as done in NIH grant but for 1 year project including hypothesis and brief experimental plan
- 3) Significance section including impact on stem cell and regenerative medicine field
- 4) Innovation section covering any interdisciplinary studies
